Why UW Premera Rural Nursing Health Initiative (RNHI) ARNP Fellowship?

Grant funded support

- Weekly didactic sessions (via Zoom) & hands on Skills Workshops at the UW School of Nursing's Simulation Center in Seattle (3 days in September 2024 & 1 day in March 2025)
- Mileage and lodging reimbursements for travel to off-site specialty rotations
- Grant-funded registration and travel to 2-day UW CNE Primary Care Conference in Seattle (October 2024)
- Access to restricted UW online library resources (UW Net IDs / email), both during the fellowship year and the year after
- Facilitated bi-monthly well-being sessions for fellows


